

Mark Partridge Short Biography

Mark Partridge is the Swank Chair of Rural-Urban Policy at Ohio State University. He is a Faculty Research Affiliate, City-Region Studies Centre, University of Alberta and an adjunct professor at the University of Saskatchewan. Professor Partridge is Co-Editor of the *Journal of Regional Science* and serves on the editorial boards of *Growth and Change*, *The Review of Regional Studies*, and *Region et Developpement*. He has published over 100 scholarly papers and coauthored the book *The Geography of American Poverty: Is there a Role for Place-Based Policy?* Professor Partridge's research has been funded by many sources including the Appalachian Regional Commission, Brookings Institution, Infrastructure Canada, Lincoln Institute of Land Policy, and Social Science and Humanities Research Council of Canada. His research includes investigating rural-urban interdependence and regional growth and policy. Dr. Partridge served as President of the Southern Regional Science Association.
